ANNOUNCEMENT

The Board of Directors of the National Association of Division 1-A Football Officials (NADFO) wishes to announce that it has expanded NADFO to include officials at the Division 1-AA, II, and III levels and renamed the organization the **National Association of Collegiate Football Officials (NACFO) – (www.nacfo.net)**.

NADFO was launched in 2003 with the goal of helping to improve the quality and consistency of college football officiating throughout the country. While its main emphasis has been on issues of particular interest to Division 1-A officials, much of its work has been done on behalf of all college officials. With the recent creation of the Collegiate Football Officiating, LLC (CFO), the board believed that this was an opportune time to formally acknowledge this larger role.

In its brief tenure, NADFO has made significant strides in several areas, such as providing a networking opportunity for officials and working with the NCAA to effect rule changes and to secure improvements in bowl compensation, coach-official relations, and security, among other things. The board believes that the expansion will enable the organization to work more effectively with the NCAA and CFO to accomplish the missions of all three groups. Conversations along this line with National Coordinator David Parry have already occurred, and further conversations with Dennis Poppe of the NCAA will take place in July.

Coordinators and officials in the Division 1-AA, II, and III conferences are being contacted regarding the expansion and its implications.
